Requirement

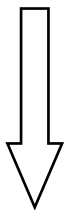
Please meet all requirements below to apply for student visa.

- ① Proof of 12 years of school education. Last school's graduation is within 5 years.
- ② Prove that you have (a) financial supporter(s) for your tuition, living while studying in Japan.
- ③ Have Japanese proficiency level of N5 Level of Japanese Language Proficiency Test of equivalent test.
- ④ Have strong will to study.

Before your first Japanese class start in Japan

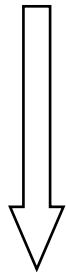
Those need to apply for student VISA follow below process.

1 Turn in Application to school



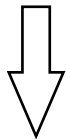
Please go to our homepage <http://kobe-nichigo.jp/> and click “How to Apply” tag.

2 Interview



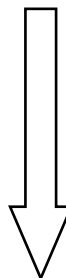
We may use online applications or face to face meetings for interviews.
We will ask questions like why you want to study in Japan.
By the interview, we will get some idea of your Japanese Language Proficiency.
We will let you know the result of the application within two days.

3 School will Apply for “Certificate of Eligibility”



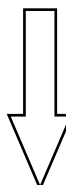
We will turn in your application to immigration services agency in Japan.

4 Receipt of result from immigration services agency



School will receive a result of your application from immigration office.
We will notify the result of your application for eligibility to you by email.
We will send our school fee guidance, and the school bank account information to you by the same email.

5 Deposit of School Fee



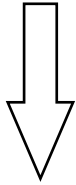
For those who received “Certificate of Eligibility”, please deposit school fee to our school bank account. After we confirm your deposit, we will send the “Certification of Eligibility” and “School Admission Certificate” to you by international post.

6 Apply for VISA at your local Japanese Embassy



After you received the “Certificate of Eligibility”, please bring it to your local Japanese Embassy to apply for VISA.

7 Come to Japan



After you receive your VISA from your local embassy, you can come to Japan to study. Please be sure to let us know the date and flight number of your arrival.

8 Come to school

After your arrival in Japan, a staff from our school will go to city office to register your address. There will be a health check at the hospital, too. After the school orientation, classes will begin at school.

Necessary Documents to Apply for “Certificate of Eligibility”

Necessary documents to apply for “Certificate of Eligibility” are different each country and everyone’s situation. We will send you a list of necessary documents you need to prepare after we receive your application for admission.

【Please be sure to read below before turning in your documents】

- ① All documents must be original. Photocopies of original documents are not accepted. All document (except for graduation certificates) must not be older than three months. Please include issue date on all documents.
- ② Please prepare Japanese translations of all documents.
- ③ All documents should be in size A4. Please use only one side of papers. Do not prepare documents in both sides of papers.
- ④ All certified document must have a name, title, address, telephone, and fax number of issuers of the document.
- ⑤ We will not return documents once received; however, we will return graduation certificates and Japanese proficiency test result certificates.
- ⑥ We will cancel our school admission in case all documents to apply for certificate of eligibility are not prepared by due date or in case we find any untrue statement in documents.

Refund Policy

- ① In case you fail to receive “certificate of eligibility” from immigration.
→We will return all payment after deducting the fee for admission testing and international bank transaction fee.

- ② In case you received “the Certificate of Eligibility”, but you fail to apply for VISA and do not come to Japan.
→Please send “the Certificate of Eligibility” and “Certificate of School Admission“ to us.
We will return all fees after deducting fees for testing, admission, and bank transaction.

- ③ In case you applied for VISA at your local Japanese embassy, but you failed to receive VISA.
→Please return “certificate of school admission” with a “proof that the local Japanese embassy did not issue VISA”. After we receive the documents, we will return the rest of the payment after deducting the fee for testing and bank transaction fee.

- ④ In case you received VISA, but you decided not to enter school before coming to Japan.
→You need to return “ the certificate of school admission”. After confirming that VISA is unused and invalid, we will return the rest of your payment after deducting the fee for testing and admission, 6 months course tuition, facility and textbooks, and bank transaction.

- ⑤ In case you obtained VISA and came to Japan and started studying Japanese in our school but failed to graduate.
→No refund of any payment

- ⑥ In case you arrive in Japan, but do not enter school.
→No refund of any payment

School Life Support

Dormitory

For the first 6 months, you can use our school dormitory. Close to supermarket, bakery, pharmacy, and bank. 7 minutes to train and bus station. It is a two and a half room fully furnished and well maintenance apartment with bath, kitchen, and dining, only 25000yen/month if you are willing to share a room with another student. 3-6 students live in one apartment. The apartment is furnished with wi-fi, refrigerator, washing machine, cooking gas, microwave, rice cooker, cooking utensils, dishes, bed, table, and chairs. Please pay 6-month rent in advance. Heat and water are billed separately. There is an insurance fee of 30000yen when you first enter a dormitory. We will refund part of your insurance after you leave. After 6 months, we will introduce an apartment for you upon your request. Dormitory rooms are limited. First come, first serve.

Share house

There is a share house 15-minutes by bicycle from school. In a share house, you get your own private room, but you share the rest of the house like kitchen, dining, living room and bathroom with house mates. In this share house, people from many countries enjoy conversation over meals in the dining room. The rent is around 55,000yen per month including heat and water.

One room or one-bedroom Apartment

The average cost for furnished and air-conditioned one-bedroom apartment is available from 35,000-50,000yen per month. There will be an insurance fee of 50,000yen when you make a contract. We will look for one if you request us to look for apartment of your own.

Part time jobs

You need "a permission to engage in activity other than that permitted by the Status of Residence Previously Granted". We will support you getting the work permit. We'll also support you finding part-time jobs for your early stable living. Please note that you will only be permitted to work less than 28 hours per week. The approximate amount you will make from working part time jobs will be around Y80,000 per month.

Scholarship

Scholarship available before entry to school

For those who took Japanese Language Proficiency Test before VISA application and passed below level, we will deduct from payment as scholarship as follows.

- ・ JLPT N2 →75,000 yen from testing fee and admission fee
- ・ JLPT N3 →21,000 yen from testing fee

Scholarship available after entry to school

- ・ An award from school president to a student with the best grade, attendance and attitude.
- ・ Attendance Award to all student with 100% attendance.
- ・ Award to all students who passed JLPT
